We sew bags that are reusable.

The advantages of the small bags are: they can be easily transported, they are transparent and washable.

With our bags we can save up to 1,000 plastic bags a year.

Product information

- frequently recyclable
- breathable
- small-mesh webbing
- weight per net fabric: 3.5 kilos
- machine-washed at 40 degrees
- They can be opened and closed by means of a drawstring.
- measurements: 30 by 40 centimetres
- please don't iron!
